Lead exposure is dangerous for young children and can cause permanent brain damage.



- ■ In Minnesota, an average of 700 children are poisoned by lead each year.
- A child disabled by lead poisoning may utilize \$100,000 per year for the rest of their life in State, Federal, and Medicaid benefits.
- This bill allocates \$1 million/year to ensure more lead-safe homes in urban and rural areas.








Faith in Action
