MISSION

To improve the lives of Dakota County residents and enhance the economic vitality of communities through housing and community development.



- Over 10,000 people are served by CDA housing programs.
 - Portfolio of over **2,900 units** of affordable rental housing serving homeless youth, single person households, disabled households, families and seniors.
 - Rental assistance programs serve over 2,600 households. Some resources target specific households (long-term homeless).



- Funding streams from local, state and federal resources; rental revenue.
- Issue housing finance resources for affordable housing developers. Funding applications provide additional points for developments that set aside units for homeless households.



- Assist cities with addressing redevelopment needs.
- Allocate federal CDBG resources to eligible activities.
- Provide support for economic development initiatives.



COVID-19 & CDA Business Operations

- Assisted Dakota County with approving businesses to receive grants
- Partnered with MN Home Ownership Center to administer grants for foreclosure prevention
- Will be working with Dakota County to administer additional federal resources (CDBG/ESG) allocated in response to COVID
